



SSE CONTRACTING LIGHTING SERVICES CLIMBING TO NEW HUYTON FOR CHARITY

A charity which helps the homeless and victims of domestic violence is the latest to attempt to climb Mount Kilimanjaro.

Arch North Staffs is putting together a team featuring SSE Contracting's Lighting Services Stoke Operations Manager Jim Huyton, Signal 1 breakfast DJ Perry Spiller, the charity's chief executive Paul Bridges and Will Ceaser, from MSL mountaineering, to scale the 5,896m of the Tanzanian peak.

The aim of the challenge is to raise money for people in North Staffordshire who are homeless or at risk of homelessness – including those fleeing domestic abuse.

Jim Huyton said: "I and the SSE team here in Stoke are proud to offer a service and welcomed the opportunity to support our local community, helping Arch to fulfil their aspirations. Hopefully our time, skills and experience will set examples and help inspire excellence in others."

DJ Perry said: "It's great to have the opportunity for this once in a lifetime challenge especially as I'll be doing it for Arch. It's a worthwhile charity working hard to support people in our area".

Arch's community and corporate fund-raiser Ray Elks said: "We are aiming to raise much needed funds with this challenge. We're grateful to Perry and our other climbers for getting involved."

The hike up Africa's highest mountain takes place between August 7 and 15.
